

40-Hour Low Pressure Boiler Course

Description: This class provides practical information on the operation, troubleshooting, and maintenance of LOW PRESSURE BOILERS, burner operation setup and maintenance; including upgrade of your current license (provided the proper paperwork is submitted to the State). Field trips and hands-on instruction are included in this course for both high or low pressure operations. **Depending on changes to the State's testing procedures, students may be able to take the State Boiler Exam on the last day of class. If the State procedures are changed, the last day will be a class day.
